Submit your abstract(s) for an oral and/or poster presentation by October 1, 2016.

Topics, such as the ones listed below, discussing case studies, lessons learned, research, practical applications, or riparian restoration related projects are encouraged.

Abstracts that specifically address adaptation in these topic areas will be given special consideration.

- Riparian woody invasives and secondary weed control measures
 - Mechanical
 - Biological
 - Cultural (e.g. grazing, land use)
 - Chemical
- Climate adaptation
- Restoration topics
 - Revegetation techniques
 - Plant materials development
 - Woody biomass utilization
 - Working with challenging soils (e.g. high salinity)
 - Restoring for wildlife
- Financing riparian restoration
- River and stream aspects
 - Flow regime
 - Channel dynamics
 - Native and invasive vegetation
 - Geomorphology
 - Sedimentation and water quality
- Social/political aspects
 - Permitting
 - Restoration on tribal and private lands
 - Cultural/recreational benefits of restoration
 - Economic impacts of restoration
 - Connecting communities
 - Volunteer, citizen science, or Conservation Corps programs/projects
- Monitoring (methods, securing funding, etc.)

Oral Presentations

Oral presentations will be 25 minutes in length (20 minutes for your presentation with 5 minutes for questions). If your abstract is accepted, you will receive additional information regarding presentation logistics and guidelines. Please note that the length of each presentation is subject to change.

Poster Presentations

Poster presentations are strongly encouraged as they allow extended informal discussions and active participation of co-authors. There will be a dedicated poster session on Tuesday, February 7 from 5-7pm (subject to change) in addition to the posters being displayed throughout the conference.

Registration Policy

All oral and poster presenters are required to register for the conference before January 7, 2017 or their abstract will risk being withdrawn from the final program. Scholarships and students rates will be available. Please indicate your interest in applying for a scholarship when you submit your abstract.

Cancellation Policy

Please do not submit an abstract if you are not confident that you will be able to attend the conference and make the presentation. Cancellations impose a serious burden on the Conference Committee and negatively impact the overall quality of the program. If your presentation has been accepted but extenuating circumstances prevent your attendance, we ask that you attempt to find another individual to make the presentation and notify us of this change as soon as possible.

This is where you state your abstract. Please begin with a concise statement of the topic or issue and end with a substantive conclusion. The body text of your abstract should be under 300 words or less, justified left. Please italicize Latin species names. Do not include figures, tables or photographs. For multi-author abstracts, place an asterisk next to the person who will be presenting. You are also encouraged to recommend a session topic that best suits your presentation.
